

Middle Urbana Missionary Baptist Church Christian Life Center Statement of Utilization

Be it known and accepted by all members of this church that the Christian Life Center is a full and proper extension of our Church. It is therefore to be utilized in a manner that promotes the Church's spirituality, doctrines, and purpose. For this reason an adult member (who is in good standing) must supervise all activities in the Christian Life Center. The Center cannot be reserved by non-members and is not to be rented out.

Church groups such as Church/Sunday School, Training Union, Reach-Out groups, Women's Missionary Circle, Children's Church shall have priority use of the Christian Life Center. Any individual member may schedule the CLC free of charge provided it does not interfere with a scheduled Church Group function and provided the responsibilities of The Christian Life Center guidelines are met. Individual requests are on a first come/ first served basis and are subject to change should a Church Group function require use of the facility. When reserving the Center for non-Church events, the Church member is responsible for supervising the activity to insure that all rules and guidelines are maintained as well as a Christian atmosphere. This member is also responsible for clean up of the Christian Life Center after the activity to the same condition prior to their activity. Failure to properly clean after a non-church function will result in \$50 invoice to the irresponsible member. Further, any damage to the property should be reported to the CLC Coordinator and/or a Deacon as soon as it is discovered.

Under no circumstances will any secular activity take place in the Christian Life Center during a regular Church, Sunday School, or Training Union Service. The Christian Life Center is used for many different activities including basketball, volleyball, plays, dinners, birthday parties, wedding receptions, bridal and baby showers, etc. The following activities are also permissible as long as Christian conduct is observed and our Church's beliefs are not inappropriately represented: Secular board games, trivia games and games using playing cards, aerobic activities, secular movies and secular music with discretion. Some of the activities not allowed: Dancing (except as part of a Church related play or activity), gambling, swearing, no alcoholic beverages are permitted on any Church property, no smoking or tobacco use allowed, and no disc jockey's at parties or inappropriate secular music and movies.

The definition of "Inappropriate" is as follows: If you are the responsible person at an event, we as a Church would not want any activity that would be questionable in nature to take place. Usually, if an activity is questionable then it should not be considered for the Christian Life Center. We would like for all of God's principles to be applied and used in every decision that goes into activities in our Christian Life Center.
